

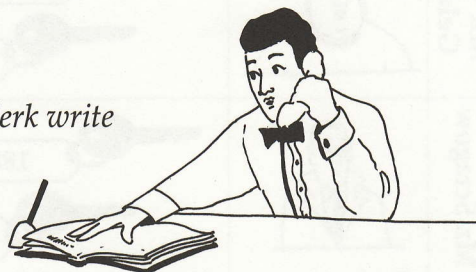


## 2 Second Challenge
